



**Last Game:** She made two 3-pt FG in Game 2 vs. New York, 8/29, the first of which broke a 4-4 tie and give her team the lead for good. Her second 3-pt FG opened the second half scoring and sent the team on its way to a 9-0 run and the biggest lead of the game (48-27).

- To her six points in Game 2, she added a rebound, an assist and a steal in 23 minutes.
- Scoring more than she had in any game since the first week of July, she tallied eight points on 2-3 3-pt FG and 1-2 from inside the arc at New York, 8/26. he added one assist in 21 minutes vs. the Liberty.
- Her three field goals at New York tied her most this season
- She has hit multiple 3-pt FG just eight times in 2010, including both of the playoff games with New

York.

- During the regular season, the Fever was 17-10 with her in the starting line, in contrast to 4-3 with her coming off the bench.
- In the last 13 games, she averaged 3.9 ppg and shot 17-39 from the floor. She hit 12-29 from 3-pt range in that span, compared to 14-48 3-pt FG (.292) in her first 21 appearances.
- She had one turnover in each of the last three games and was second in the WNBA with a ratio of 1.20 steals for every turnover.
- Her 15 steals in the last 15 games gave her 542 in her career and moved her ahead of former teammate Yolanda Griffith into fourth place on the WNBA's all-time career list.
- With the first of her two 3-pt FG at Minnesota, 6/6, she became the seventh player in history to score 1,000 points in a Fever uniform.

**Career & Personal Highlights**

- She returned to the Fever for a sixth season after assuming point guard duties in 2005
- She has led the Fever to five seasons of at least 21 wins and six straight WNBA playoff appearances
- Indiana is 123-85 (.591) in six seasons since her arrival with the franchise and it is 117-71 (.622) in games she has started
- She had arguably the best season of her pro career in 2009, scoring 209 points with 97 assists and 62 steals – all of which were the second-best totals of her career
- She has been named to the WNBA All-Defensive Team in five straight seasons
- She boasts 12 years of WNBA experience and a WNBA Championship (Seattle, 2004)
- She eclipsed the 1,500-point barrier during the 2009 season
- She has annually ranked among WNBA leaders in steals per 40 minutes and she led the WNBA in steals per turnover in both 2004 and 2005
- She recently signed to return to her home state of Western Australia, where she will play in the WNBL for her first professional team, the Perth Lynx. She has not played in the WNBL since 2008. She played with the Lynx from 1991 through 2000, and then again in 2003-04, before moving over to the Canberra Capitals for the 2004-05 through 2007-08 seasons. She helped lead the Capitals to the WNBL title in 2006 and 2007.

**Last Game:** Registering the 15th double-double of her 30-game postseason career, she led the Fever with 17 points and 13 rebounds in Game 2 vs. New York, 8/29. She also had one assist, two steals and just one turnover against the Liberty.

- Before Game 2 vs. New York, she was named the WNBA's Defensive Player of the Year for an unprecedented fourth time, and the second year in a row. She has been named to the WNBA's All-Defensive First Team in each of the six years it has been selected.
- While leading the Fever in points with 18, assists with six and steals with four, she also had seven rebounds and a team-high two blocked shots in Game 1 at New York, 8/26.
- Including 10-12 FT vs. Minnesota, 8/22, she hit a season-best 10 free throws four times in 2010.

Her 157 FTM and 185 FTA ranked fourth highest in the league.

- Her double-double vs. Minnesota was the 68th of her career, tying her with former teammate Natalie Williams for sixth on the WNBA's all-time career list.
- The only member of the Fever to lead the team in points, rebounds and assists in the same game, she did so 10 times in 2010.
- She hit 207 field goals this season, second most in Fever history. She set the franchise record with 221 field goals in 2003.
- At New York, 8/17, she shot 6-7 from 3-pt range, tying a franchise record for 3-pt field goals.
- She hit 17-31 from long distance in the last seven games and was second in the league in 3-pt FG accuracy with a mark of 44.8 percent. That is the third highest mark for a single season in franchise history.
- After scoring 20+ points in just two of the first 16 games, she did so 10 times in the last 18, including 24+ points in six of the last 10 games.
- The game vs. Atlanta, 8/6, was the eighth 30-point game of her career and with it she topped the 4,500-point in her career. She is the first player in WNBA history to score 4,500 points, grab 2,000 rebounds and hand out 1,000 assists in her career.
- Her one steal vs. New York, 8/3, was the 700th of her career and her assist in that game was the 1,000th of her career in the WNBA. She is the second player in league history with 700 thefts (708) in her career.
- She was 13th in the WNBA with a team-best 3.97 apg.
- A career 40 percent shooter from the field, she was 14th in the WNBA with a mark of 48.4 percent (207-428) FG in 2010.

**Career & Personal Highlights**

- She led the Fever in points per game, rebounds, assists and steals in each of her first six active pro seasons – no other WNBA player has led her team in as many categories in even one of those seasons
- She was named the WNBA's Defensive Player of the Year for the third time in 2009...she and Sheryl Swoopes are the only three-time winners of the award
- She has finished among the top three in balloting for the WNBA MVP Award in four of her eight active pro seasons and has finished among the top five in MVP balloting in 7 of 8 active seasons
- She has scored in 279 of 280 games played in her pro career...she is a six-time WNBA All-Star and seven-time All-WNBA recipient

**Last Game:** While scoring 10 points on 4-8 FG and 2-2 FT in Game 2 vs. New York, 8/29, she also had eight boards, an assist and a postseason career-high tying three blocked shots in 18 minutes.

- She entered the 2009 WNBA Finals never having scored more than five points in a postseason game. However, she has scored at least eight in four of her last six playoff outings.
- While the team has shot just over 41 percent FG in the series, she has canned 8-15 FG (.533).
- In her last five playoff games dating back to 2009, she has shot 21-36 FG (.583).
- She had never claimed more than three rebounds in a playoff game until 2010 and she recorded eight boards in each of the two games in this series.

- While leading the Fever with a postseason career-high eight rebounds from the bench, she added eight points on 4-7 FG against her former team in New York, 8/26. Against the Liberty, she had more than one offensive rebound for the first time ever in the playoffs with a team-best four.
- She set a Fever franchise single-season record by hitting 57.1 percent from the floor (96-168 FG).
- She scored 10+ points 10 times in 2010.
- She averaged 9.5 ppg in the last 15 games. For the season, she was fifth on the team with an average of 7.4 ppg/
- She grabbed more than five rebounds three times in 2010, all of which came in the last 10 games.
- She blocked multiple shots seven times in 2010.
- Her three blocked shots vs. Minnesota gave her 27 this season, her most since rejecting 29 shots in 33 games as a rookie with New York in 2007.
- She collected seven steals in the last 15 games, in contrast to just seven steals in her first 19 appearances.
- Gathering double-digit rebounds for just the second time in her career, and first time in a Fever uniform, she had a game-high 12 boards and a career-best six offensive rebounds at Atlanta, 8/1.
- Her six offensive rebounds against the Dream tied the most for any member of the Fever this season.

**Career & Personal Highlights**

- Signed after a season-ending injury to Yolanda Griffith, she played in 26 games in 2009 and averaged 2.8 points, 1.5 rebounds and 0.54 blocks
- She posted the team's highest field goal percentage, shooting 52.7 percent from the field
- She ranked third in the WNBA in blocks per 40 minutes with 3.09
- She was second on the team in blocks per game
- She had a season-high 13 points twice, at San Antonio, 7/23, and at Connecticut, 9/13.
- The No. 2 pick in the 2007 WNBA Draft, Davenport was signed by the Fever as a free agent four games into the 2009 regular season after being waived by the New York Liberty
- The first Ohio State player ever to don a Fever uniform, she joins Katie Douglas as former players of the year in the Big Ten Conference to play for the Fever
- After seeing limited minutes during the 2009 regular season, she sparked Indiana in the WNBA Finals by scoring in double figures twice, including a career-high 18 points in the deciding Game 5.

- Blocking more than one shot for the first time this season, and just the sixth time in her career, she had two rejections to go with two points (1-2 FG) at New York, 8/17.
- Prior to the game at New York she had blocked a total of two shots in 31 games.

- After going 0-2 from the foul line in her first three appearances of the season, she made 25-28 FT in her last 30 outings.

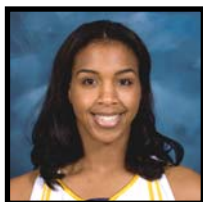

- Bridging the regular season and playoffs, she has scored 10+ points in three straight games--her second longest stretch in 2010. She has scored in double figures in eight of the last 13 games, compared to just four games of 10+ points in the first 23.
- She connected on 4-8 FG and 2-3 FT for her 10 points in 28 minutes at New York, 8/26. She added four rebounds, one assist, two steals and a blocked shot against the Liberty.
