A back-and-forth game came down to the final two minutes and the Tulsa Shock were unable to execute down the stretch, falling to the Atlanta Dream, 96-90, at Philips Arena earlier this afternoon. With the win, Atlanta became the first Eastern Conference team to reach double-digit wins and maintained its first place standing with a 10-4 record. The loss was the Shock's sixth loss in a row, the longest such streak in the WNBA this season, dropping their record to 3-9 on the season. The Shock trailed by as many as 18 in the first half before clawing back and taking the lead on numerous occasions in the second half. However, with the game tied 86-86 with a little over two minutes left in the game, the Shock were unable to take the lead on three consecutive offensive possessions allowing Atlanta to finally break the tie on a three-point play by Sancho Lyttle to put the Dream up 89-86. Four Shock players were scored in double-figures: Scholanda Robinson (17 points), Braxton (15), Amber Holt (14) and Jennifer Lacy (13).

The Tulsa Shock dropped their fifth-straight game and fell to 3-8 on the season with a pair of weekend losses to the Minnesota Lynx. The Shock fell in Minneapolis 78-67 on Friday before seeing a similar result at the BOK Center on Saturday, losing 92-78. Tulsa sought to defend their home court on Saturday night, but was prevented by a Minnesota three-point barrage, shooting 12-19 on the night from behind the arc, including a 7-of-8 first half performance. Tulsa had four players in double-figures and shot an even 50 percent on the evening. Tulsa out-rebounded Minnesota 30-27, but were outscored from the three-point line 36-12. Everyone on the Shock roster played at least ten minutes. The Lynx improved to 4-9, with three of those wins coming against the Shock. Tulsa dropped the season series against Minnesota losing three out of five after having played Minnesota in five out of their first 11 games.

After having the lead for most of the game, a low scoring fourth quarter sunk the Shock against the Minnesota Lynx, 67-78, on June 18. The Shock led after each quarter but managed only 10 points in the fourth quarter, losing the quarter by 12 points. Seimone Augustus, playing the Shock for the first time, put up 27 points for the game shooting 11-of-19 from the field and 5 of 10 from three. Turnovers once again plagued the Shock; they gave up 21 during the game diminishing the impact of their 10 steals and 10 blocks. The Shock held the Lynx to a 31.6% shooting percentage which Minnesota overcame by collecting 10 more offensive rebounds (14-4) than the Shock. Tulsa shot a higher percentage than the Lynx during every quarter but the fourth. Kiesha Brown led the team in scoring with 14 points, with Scholanda Robinson being the only other player to score double digits with 13. Newcomer Tiffany Jackson shot 25% FGs, made two free-throws and snagged four rebounds.

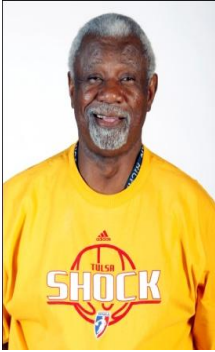

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.
- Won first pre-season game, 90-80, over the Seattle Storm.

### GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.
